Dear Mr. Stewart:

I am writing to you on behalf of the Hamlet Council and the people of Baker Lake.

We are asking you to abandon the Kiggavik project.

On different occasions you have publicly stated that if the people of Baker Lake did not want this proposed uranium mine to go ahead then your company would not proceed.

At a recent meeting of the Hamlet Council the Council unanimously voted to oppose Kiggavik. Of course the plebiscite, with results of 397 "NO", 43 "YES", confirms this is the wishes of the people of Baker Lake.

With the foregoing in mind we ask you to keep your word and abandon this project.

By a copy of this letter we are asking your partners to reconsider their involvement.
